DISCERNING GOD'S VISION FOR THE CHURCH

1. The church exists because of God's initiative, not ours.
2. The church has a unique mission to be a sign, a foretaste and an instrument of the coming reign of God. Each congregation is to embody in its life and ministry what it means to live within the reign of God.
3. The church does not invent its own vision of the future, but must discern and express God's vision, which sets our agenda, direction and priorities.
